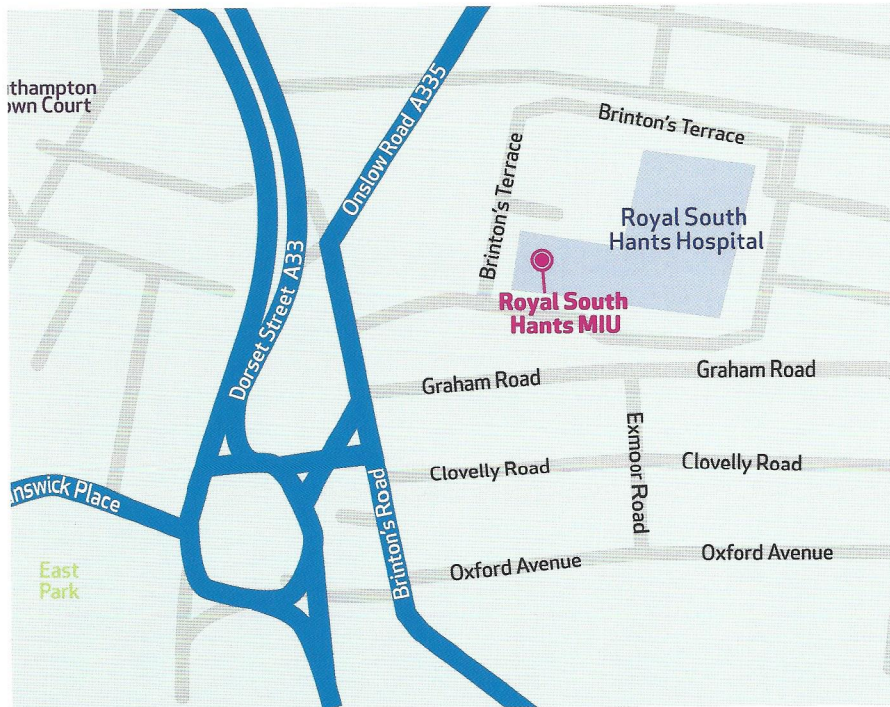


Parking available
