The Members 'Code of Conduct' is based on and consistent with the following principles:

Selflessness: holders of public office should act solely in terms of the public interest, they should not do so in order to gain financial or other material benefit

Integrity: holders of public office should not place themselves under any financial or other obligation to outside individuals or organisations that might seek to influence them in the performance of their official duties

Objectivity: in carrying out all public business holders of public office should make choices on merit

Accountability: holders of public office are accountable for their decisions and actions to the public

Openness: holders of public office should be as open as possible about all the decisions and actions that they take; they should give reasons for their decisions and restrict information only when the wider interest

Honesty: holders of public office have a duty to declare any private interests Relating to their public duties and take steps to resolve any conflicts arising in a way that protects the public interest

Leadership: holders of public office should promote and support these principles by leadership and example
